

Making Nouns Plural

Spanish Grammar Rules

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- ▶ All nouns in Spanish have gender. There is nothing that is neuter. Everything is either male or female.
- ▶ The best way to learn a noun's gender is to memorize it with its article.

Articles

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- ▶ Definite articles would all translate to the word “the” in English.
- ▶ Indefinite articles would translate to “a” or “an” in the singular and to “some” in the plural.

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 - If the word ends in -z, change the -z to -c and add -es

Examples

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- ▶ el profesor-->los profesores

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- ▶ Therefore, el lunes becomes los lunes.
- ▶ Note: Both can mean Monday, but they can also be translated to ON Monday or ON Mondays. Spanish usually doesn't put a preposition in for that.
